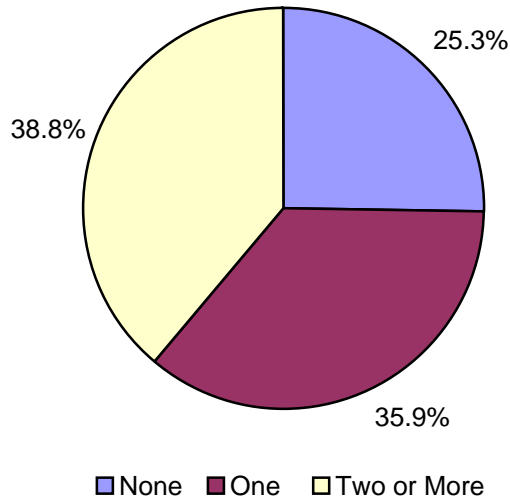

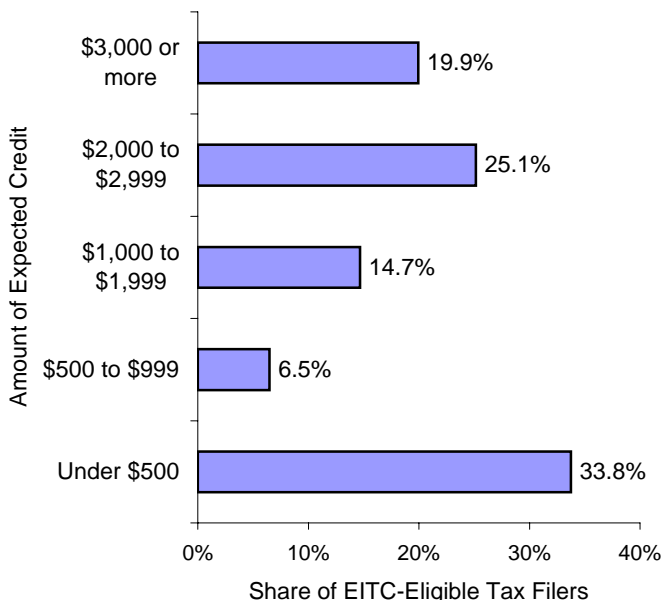

Size of Expected Earned Income Tax Credit

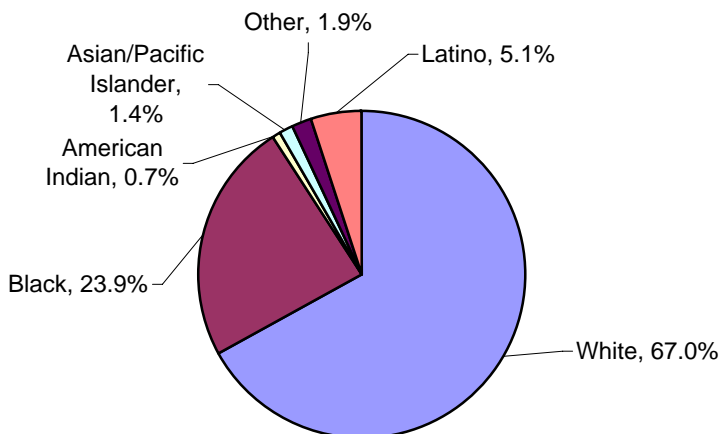

Race and Ethnicity of Taxpayer

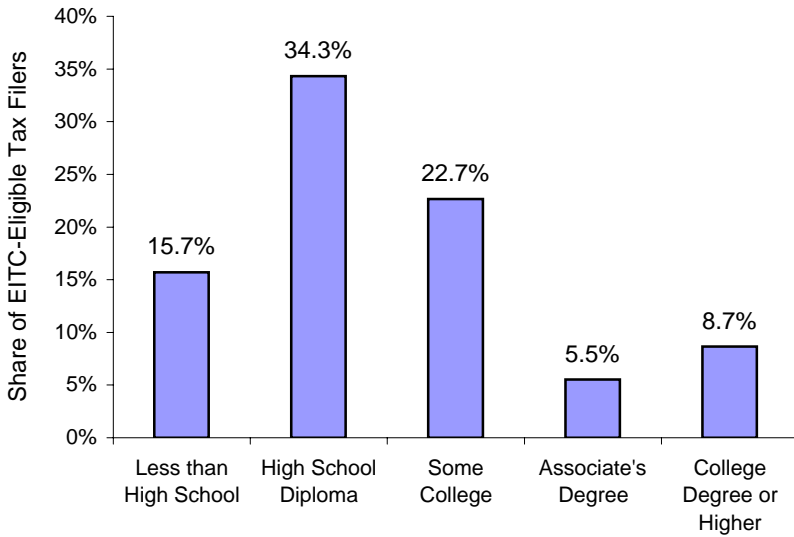

Receipt of Food Stamps

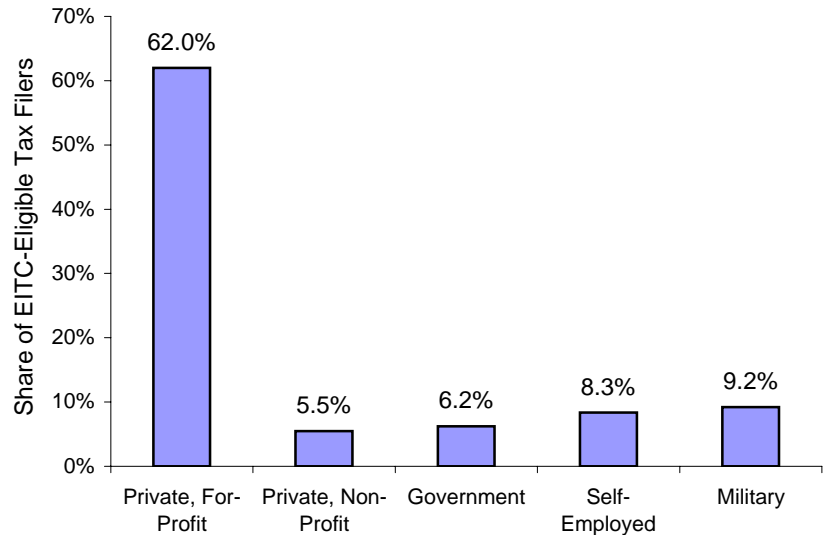
